

TLILIC2001 Licence to Operate a Forklift Truck

PERSONS WHO WOULD BENEFIT FROM THIS COURSE

This unit is appropriate for those working in:

and whom are required to operate an industrial forklift truck as a part of their job description.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The aim of this course is to provide the student with the underpinning skills and knowledge to competently operate a forklift to meet minimum training and assessment standards for the purpose of certification.

COURSE PREREQUISITE

- Student must be over 18 years of age
- Student must be able to read and write in English as prescribed by regulation
- The student must have sound written and mathematical skills
- 100 points of valid ID as per the licensing requirements of Part 4.5 of the Model Work Health and Safety (WHS) Regulations to meet Commonwealth, State and Territory HRW licensing requirements

PERFORMANCE CRITERIA

- Plan work
- Conduct routine checks
- Shift load
- Shut down and secure forklift truck

COURSE OUTLINE

- Accurately interpret information relating to conducting forklift truck operations (e.g. procedures)
- Safely conduct forklift truck operations including all functions to the maximum height and load capacity
- Identify hazards associated with the operation of the forklift truck, assess risks and put into place effective hazard prevention/control measures for those hazards identified
- Verify problems and equipment faults and demonstrate appropriate response procedures
- Methodology of determining the weight of a load
- WHS legislation, standards relevant to the safe operation for the forklift trucks
- Understanding of forklift characteristics and capabilities (including use of load data plates)
- Understanding of the hierarchy of hazard identification and control
- Organisational and workplace standards, requirements, policies and procedures
- Procedures for the recording, reporting and maintenance of workplace records and information
- Forklift truck operations and safe operating techniques
- Typical routine problems encountered in the operation of the crane and equipment and adjustments required for correction

COURSE STRUCTURE & COURSE DURATION

Full Training & Assessment Course: Formal Training, Theory and Calculations Assessment and Final Practical Assessment. 4 days duration.

Formal Training, Theory and Calculation Assessment and Logbook:

Formal Training is completed.

Written knowledge test and calculation assignment can be completed at the end of the formal training, logbook hours under a ticketed supervisor.

Student can request a practical final assessment when they feel ready.

2 days plus 1 day for final practical assessment.
