

## CPCCLSF3001A Licence to Erect, Alter and Dismantle Scaffolding Intermediate Level

### PERSONS THAT WOULD BENEFIT FROM THIS COURSE

---

This unit is appropriate for those working in heavy industries and whom are required to operate as an intermediate scaffolder as a part of their job description.

### COURSE DESCRIPTION

---

This course is designed to provide students with the skills and knowledge required to erect, alter and dismantle scaffolding at the intermediate level, consisting of scaffolding work connected with the operation or use of modular or pre-fabricated scaffolds, cantilevered materials hoists with a maximum working load of 500kg, ropes and gin wheels, safety nets and static lines, and bracket scaffolds (tank and formwork) for licensing purposes. This unit is based upon the National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work.

### COURSE PREREQUISITE

---

- Student must be over 18 years of age
- Student must be able to read and write in English as prescribed by regulation
- The student must have sound written and mathematical skills
- 100 points of valid ID as per the licensing requirements of Part 4.5 of the Model Work Health and Safety (WHS) Regulations to meet Commonwealth, State and Territory HRW licensing requirements
- CPCCLSF2001A Licence to erect, alter and dismantle scaffolding basic level
